

Uniform & Dress Code Policy Specifics

2007-2008 school year

1. Shoes – Students must wear predominantly dark shoes, i.e. brown, black, gray, navy blue.
 - a. This allows students and parents more leeway in finding school shoes that are comfortable and good for the child’s feet.
 - b. Tennis shoes or dress shoes are allowed.
 - c. Shoes with predominantly light/bright colors, however “dark” they seem, are not permitted, i.e. pink, red, orange, yellow. No white shoes.
 - d. Shoes may have a small amount of brighter color in the design.

2. Along with All School Uniforms, our main uniform provider, parents may purchase uniform pants and shirts from JCPenney.
 - a. Vests, cardigans, ties, skirts, and culottes must still be purchased from All School Uniforms.
 - b. The correct uniform pants and shirts can be found in JCPenney’s school uniform catalog. The brand of pants (Khaki and Navy) will be determined when the new school uniform catalog comes out. The shirts are long-sleeve or short-sleeve oxfords with the button collar or Peter Pan collared blouses (girls grades 1-5); the brand will be determined when the new school uniform catalog comes out. Pants and shirts will be available through catalog orders, online, and often at the store.
 - c. This allows parents some option for getting their uniforms from a vendor that is closer and more convenient on short notice. Parents can also price compare.
 - d. JCPenney School Uniform Catalogs – once published – are available in the catalog department of any JCPenney store, including the one at the Westminster Mall.
